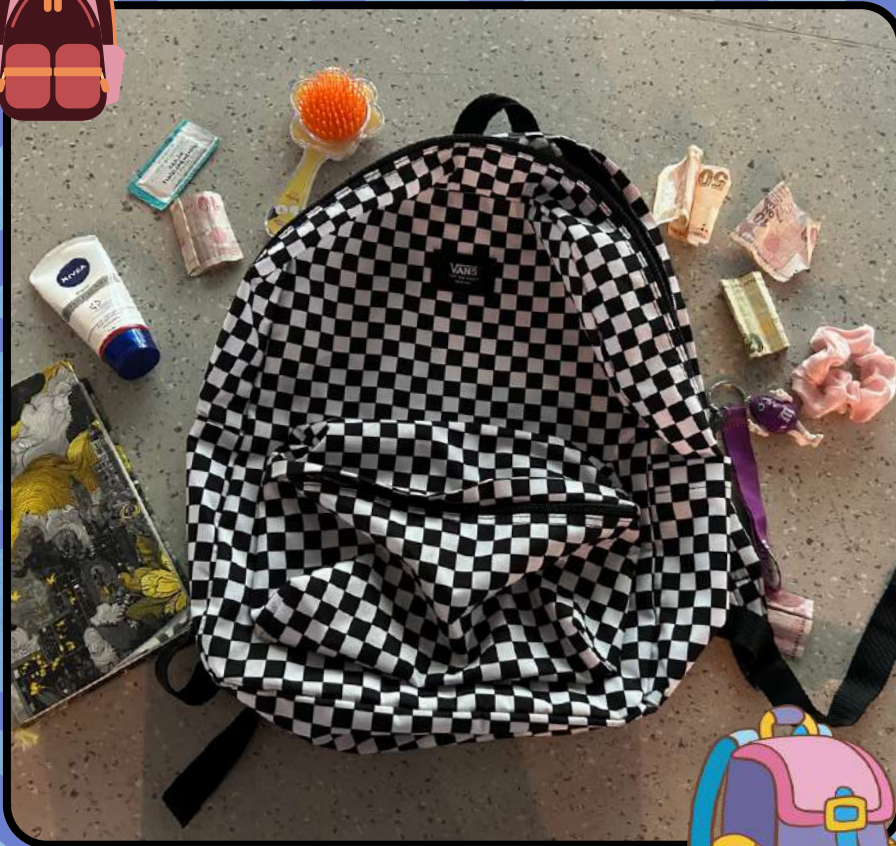

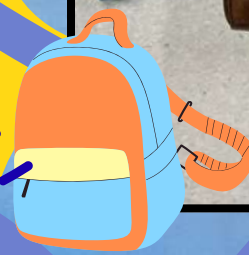

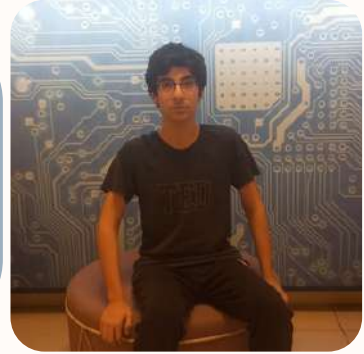

International Love Day

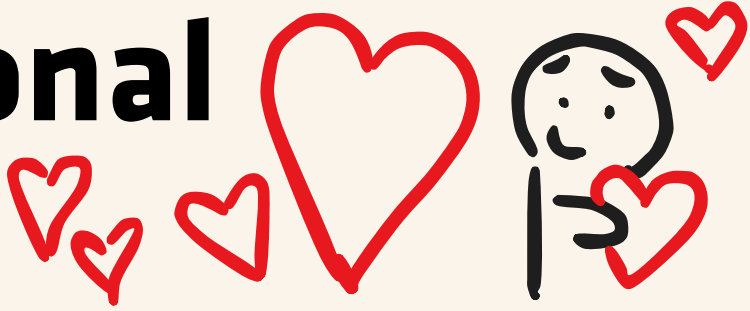

The Lost Twin

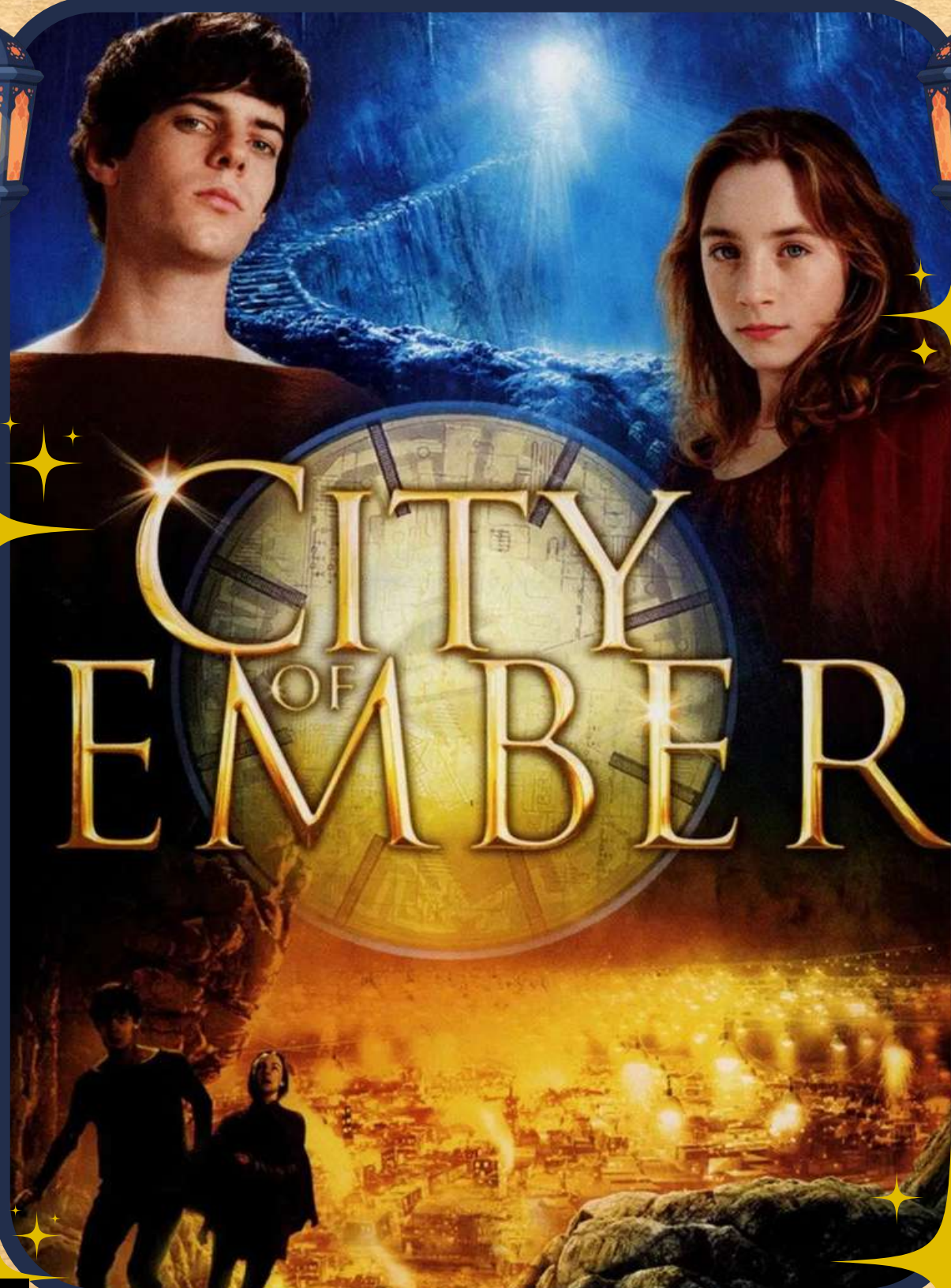
